I assume all risks and hazards incidental to such participation including transportation to and from such activities, and I do hereby waive, release, absolve, indemnity and agree to hold harmless the Texas Youth Football Association (TYFA), the Host Organization, the sponsors, supervisors, participants, volunteers and persons transporting my child to and from activities for any claim arising out of injury to my child.

Physical Examination: I, the Guardian of this child, believe to the best of my knowledge that he/she can withstand the rigors of a football or cheerleading season. I, the Parent/Guardian, believe there is nothing physically/mentally wrong with my child. I, the Parent/Guardian, hereby give my approval to my child to participate in the upcoming season without a physical examination which is recommended by TYFA. I assume all risks and hazards incidental to such participation without a physical and do hereby waive, release, absolve, indemnity and agree to hold harmless, TYFA, the host organization, the sponsors, supervisors, participants, volunteers and any other persons involved in TYFA.

Equipment Liability: I understand that Guardians are responsible for the return of all the required equipment and uniforms, clean and in good condition to the host organization. And that We the Parent/Guardians will be responsible for reimbursement to the host organization any cost of lost or excessively damaged equipment and or uniforms.

Age Verification: I, the undersigned give TYFA and its agents the right to verify my child's age with his/her school if my child's age comes into question or is challenged by a TYFA organization.

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Flag Football registration cost is \$115. Players will receive the following: Game jersey with last name on the back, Game pants, Game Socks and 1 Mouth Piece. (Game Pants must be returned at the end of the season). Our flag team always wears football pants instead of shorts, we want every football player from ages 5 to 11 to have the same look. Flag registration also includes TYFA Certification, end of season trophy, entry to our end of season banquet and a end of game snack pack. An example of a end of game snack pack is a Hot Dog, chips and beverage. All flag players will need to provide their own cleats.

Tackle Football registration cost is \$135. Players will receive the following: Game jersey with last name on the back, Game pants, Game Socks, Mouth Piece and helmet decal. (Game Pants must be returned at the end of the season) Tackle registration also includes 1 practice jersey, TYFA Certification, end of season trophy, entry to our end of season banquet and a end of game snack pack. An example of a end of game snack pack is a Hot Dog, chips and beverage. Tackle players must provide the following: Helmet (must be white with a grey face mask), Chin Strap, Shoulder Pads, 7 piece pad set, girdle and practice pants. A date will be scheduled for anyone wanting to purchase any of these items through our equipment provider. You can also purchase these from a sporting goods store. All tackle football players will need to provide their own cleats.

If you currently have equipment it will need to be inspected by our coaching staff for proper fit and for safety reasons.

Cheerleading registration cost is \$75. If you do not have a Cardinals Cheer uniform, the uniform package is \$165 plus registration fee of \$75. This includes Cheer top, skirt, briefs, socks, T-shirt, shorts, cheer bag, hair bow, shoes and Poms. Total cost for new cheerleaders is \$240. The \$165 uniform package cost will need to be paid at the uniform sizing (June/July 2010). Returning cheerleaders will be able to purchase certain items if needed. Cheerleading registration includes TYFA Certification and competition fees, end of season trophy and entry to our end of season banquet. Additional competition training such as tumbling classes are not included in registration.

Participants Code of Conduct/Behavior

As a participant in the Converse Cardinals Youth Football and Cheerleading organization there are rules and a standard of conduct that must be followed at all times. I understand that my failure to follow these rules may result in my suspension from play or dismissal from participation in the Converse Cardinals Youth Football and Cheerleading Program.

- Success or failure is not measured in terms of winning or losing. How I conduct myself on the field of play is most important.
- I will respect my coaches, League officials, and referees. My coaches are here to teach me how to play/cheer. I will do as I am told.
- I will treat my teammates and opponents with respect. They are here for the same reasons that I am.
- I will make every effort to make all of my practices. I understand that my teammates are counting on me as part of a team.
- I will not use any profanity towards my teammates, opponents, coaches, or officials. I understand that my coaches or league officials may disqualify me from playing.
- I will always show good sportsmanship and not engage in any cheer or chant which is negative in nature.
- I understand that if I am disqualified during a game or competition for inappropriate behavior that I will be suspended from next week's game or dismissed from my team by League officials.
- I will work hard in school so that my grades are as high as they can be.
- I will not leave a practice field or game without notification of my coach or permission from my coach.
- I will be responsible for my uniform/equipment.
- I understand that if I engage in fighting of any kind that I will be disqualified for a minimum of one game.
- I will abide by the decision of the referees and judges. I will not use profanity towards these individuals.
- I understand that cheerleading and football are team sports. Therefore, I will put my personal objectives second to the team's objectives.
- I will ask my coach and/or League official for a copy of specific team rules.



Parents/Guardian Code of Conduct/Behavior

As a parent of a participant of the Converse Cardinals Youth Football and Cheerleading organization, I understand there are rules and standards of conduct, which must be followed at all times.

- I/we will attend the parents/guardian meeting to gain a clear understanding of our League expectations or meet with League officials and understand the rules and objectives of the League.
- I/we will pick my child up promptly, within 15 minutes from practice or game. I will notify the coach if someone else will take my child home.
- I/we will not use or tolerate the use of alcohol or anyone under the influence of alcohol during any TYFA/Converse Cardinals event.
- I/we agree that the objectives of the Cardinals are best met if I participate along with my child. The progress made by my child and other participants is lost without my participation or attendance.
- I/we appreciate the time and energy that coaches and volunteers generously give to this program, and I will support them in their approach and their determination as to the role of each participant.
- I/we will do all I can to make sure my son or daughter fulfills the commitment he or she is making to the program.
- I/we will attend as many games as possible, both home and away.
- I/we understand that depending on the success of my son or daughter's team, the season may extend into November and/or December.
- I/we will not use profanity towards any participant, coach, or official.
- I/we will review team rules with my son and daughter and will reinforce them.
- I/we will provide the Cardinals with emergency contact in the event of my unavailability.
- I/we will reinforce to my son or daughter the qualities of being part of a team and placing personal objectives second to team objectives.
- I/we will be responsible for my behavior at games and understand that I may be asked to leave if my behavior is not appropriate.
- I/we will be responsible for behavior of other family or friends that I bring to games.
